Paying For Camp

Application Fee: \$50

\$25.00 for additional siblings

All campers must pay a \$50 application fee. This is required to process all applications. If you receive a DFI Title XX Grant (see description below) this fee will be refunded to you at the end of camp or can be applied to credit at the camp store.

If DFI Title XX Grant is not received this fee will be applied to tuition.

If camper is not accepted to attend, or camp sessions are full this fee will be refunded.

Sliding Scale Camperships

Due to fund raising efforts and the generosity of individuals, Holiday Home Camp can offer a limited number of camperships that pay partial or full tuition for a summer camp experience. We are happy to offer a sliding fee based on your income.

SCOPE

Illinois Residents

DFI Title XX Camping Services
